OLYMPIC SCHOLARSHIPS FOR ATHLETES "PYEONGCHANG 2018"

Dear President,

We refer to the above-mentioned Olympic solidarity (OS) programme and thank you for your applications.

These Olympic scholarships will be operational as listed above and will continue, subject to the conditions noted in the scholarship agreement, until 28 February 2018.

The programme is designed as a long term investment in a limited number of athletes and we know that between the start of the scholarships and the Olympic Winter Games PyeongChang 2018 a number of scholarships will be cancelled for personal reasons, injury, non-qualification etc. In order to award the maximum number of scholarships, we over budget when making the allocations, knowing a number of scholarships will be cancelled. Part of this strategy which has been in place for many editions of the programme is that the replacement of these athletes is not foreseen.

SCHOLARSHIP AGREEMENT: Athlete / NF / NOC

- The agreement lists the responsibilities and obligations of the parties involved as well as the administrative procedures of the programme.
- You will find attached a copy of the scholarship agreement that must be signed by athlete, NF and NOC. Copies must be given to the three signees as well as OS for a scholarship to be activated.

PAYMENT OF THE SCHOLARSHIPS

- Olympic Solidarity will proceed with the payment of the first period of the scholarships upon reception of one copy of all the agreements correctly signed by the athlete, NF and NOC.

- The payment of the following periods will be made upon reception and approval of the scholarship holders' **Evaluation Forms and NOC Financial Report** for the preceding period.
- The payments will be made to your NOC which have the responsibility to distribute the funds according to Point 12 of the scholarship agreement.

REPORTS

Evaluation Form

- The attached evaluation form must be completed and duly signed by the athlete, NF and NOC and then returned to OS at the end of each scholarship period.

Financial Report

- One OS financial report must be completed, according to the attached completion example, for all your scholarship holders at the end of each period.

All scholarship holder reports (Evaluation Forms, NOC Financial Report) for each four month period must be submitted together. The scholarship payment will be released once all documents have been accepted.

SUPPORT FOR QUALIFICATION COMPETITIONS

OS offers **US\$5'000.-** additional funding to scholarship holders to cover their transport costs for participation in Olympic qualification competitions. For NOCs with more than 10 athletes, for budgetary reasons, the total budget may not exceed US\$50'000.-.

Please note that just one reimbursement will be made per athlete upon reception of the completed standard Financial Report (please refer to attached example for completion instructions). It is accordingly advisable to wait until your athlete has used the full budget or that he/she has qualified or has no further qualification opportunities before submitting a request for reimbursement. The request will be subject to approval by OS according to the qualification and participation criteria for the Olympic Winter Games PyeongChang 2018.

This strategy, which has been in place for many editions of the programme, is based on the principle that the replacement of these athletes is not foreseen.

- The payment of the following periods will be made upon reception and approval of the scholarship holders' **Evaluation Forms and NOC Financial Report** for the preceding period.
- The payments will be made to your NOC which have the responsibility to distribute the funds as noted in Point 12 of the scholarship agreement.

REPORTS

Evaluation Form

- The attached evaluation form must be completed and duly signed by the athlete, NF and NOC and then returned to OS at the end of each scholarship period.

Financial Report

- One OS financial report must be completed, according to the attached completion example, for all your scholarship holders at the end of each period.

It is the responsibility of your NOC to ensure all scholarship holder reports (Evaluation Forms, NOC Financial Report) are fully and correctly completed and submitted together immediately after the end of each scholarship period. The following scholarship payment will be released once all the documents have been accepted.

In order not to penalise your scholarship holders that have reported on time, should the reporting be delayed by one or more of your scholarship holders, the athlete(s) concerned should be contacted by your NOC. If their reports are then still not submitted, OS should be informed and appropriate measures will be taken (final warning, scholarship cancellation, etc.)

If the scholarship reports have not been submitted by your NOC to OS by the end of the following scholarship period (i.e. 4 month delay), the period in question will be considered void.
